#### **EMERGENCY GRANTS:**

NOMV is offering financial support to veterinary clinics worldwide to stay open or reopen during or following natural and human-caused disasters.

This includes but is not limited to earthquakes, COVID-19, fires, floods, the Russia-Ukraine war, and the Palestine-Israel conflict.

#### **SUPPORT GRANTS:**

Individuals\* who have experienced a personal crisis and are in need of financial assistance for housing or groceries can apply for a grant of up to \$750 USD.

\*Anyone working in the veterinary field or who is currently enrolled in school for veterinary medicine or a veterinary technician program is eligible to apply.


International Survivors of Suicide Loss Day is an event in which survivors of suicide loss come together to find connection, understanding, and hope through their shared experience.
